The *Beet Salad* with a light citrus-cilantro drizzle and toasted goat cheese medallion paired with the tender *Carpaccio* with Grana Padano cheese and Modena balsamic is a perfect example of how mixing and matching small plates allows members to taste more and eat less!"

For entree lovers, the slow-braised *Osso Bucco*, the porcini rubbed *Filet Mignon*, and the spicy *Seafood Pasta* have impressed even our most discerning members. Bob Bohannon - Arizona Club Icon



Every club has revered members, and Arizona Club is no exception. Bob Bohannon is *Mr. Arizona Club* just as Barry Goldwater was *Mr. Arizona*. Bob has been a member of the Club since 1948.

Bob was born in Columbus, Ohio, attended Ohio State University and graduated with a BS in Accounting in 1942. While at Ohio State he was a member of the Army Air Corp ROTC and upon graduation was commissioned an officer and assigned to Luke Air Force Base. Later, Bob was reassigned to Yuma Air Base, rising to the rank of Lt. Col. as the Base's Adjutant.

After the military, he started a grocery business and was the founder of the Arizona Association of Grocers. He developed several large mortgage companies and retired as the President of Southwest Savings.

Bob's roots go beyond Ohio back to the crossing of the Mayflower and the Brewster and White families. He has held national offices with Sons of the American Revolution, was Governor of Arizona Mayflower Society, President of the Economic Club of Phoenix, and is a member of the Downtown Lions Club.

His love of horses led to his introducing competitive trail-riding to Arizona. Subsequently he was President of the Horsemen's Association, member of the Maricopa County Sheriff's Posse, and one of the original *Verde Vaqueros*. In addition, he was one of the first Republicans elected to the State House of Representatives in 1948 and was seated next to the only Communist elected in Arizona's Lower House. He was the Commissioner of Welfare from 1950-1952.

Bob's family includes his wife, Margaret, his children, Robb and Lisa, three grandchildren and four great-grandchildren. Besides his love for his family, friends and now only two horses, his other love is his eight cars, his favorite being his 1980 Lincoln.

Given his integrity, personality, sense of humor, and many contributions, Bob Bohannon is indeed **Mr. Arizona Club!**
